Confirmation II Requirements 2018-2019

The student must have completed all Confirmation One requirements, be in at least 10th grade, and also currently be enrolled in Faith Formation (to be called FF) at this parish or attend a Catholic high school. In order to be confirmed the student must observe the following:

- **❖** Weekly Sunday **Mass attendance**
- September 19, 2018-First day of **FF** and 'Meet the Catechist' with your parents in the **Parish Hall**. This will be parent and youth orientation.
- ❖ Turn in a copy of the teen's **Baptismal Certificate** by Oct. 17, 2018.
- ❖ Choose a sponsor that meets guidelines for sponsors and turn in **Sponsor Form** by Oct. 17, 2018
- ❖ Confirmation Name- Review a book of Saints and choose a name for Confirmation. In choosing a Saint, consider the special and unique characteristics of the saint and how you may aspire to achieve similar traits. Then write a 1 page paper describing who the saint is, special events in the saint's life, how the saint lived and the uniqueness of the saint from a religious perspective. Also include several paragraphs on why you chose the saint and what qualities in the saint's life you want to imitate in your Christian walk with the Lord. This is due Oct. 24, 2018
- November 7, 2018 (Wed.) attend Confirmation II **Sponsor/Teen Evening of Reflection** 7:00 p.m. 8:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall.
- ❖ Attend both **Sacrament Sundays** on Dec.2, 2018 and Jan. 20, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Make ups will be Tuesday, March 12 and Wednesday, March 13, 2018 from 7:45 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.
- ❖ Attend all FF classes —only 2 missed classes allowed per school year.
- ❖ Attend FF the first scheduled Wednesday of each month with a parent or sponsor.
- ***** Know all the prayers on prayer sheet
- ❖ Service Projects Four approved service projects during the two years of Confirmation preparation- at least one projects completed the first year- turn in by February 20, 2019.
- ❖ Attend the **Confirmation retreat** for teens Feb. 8-10, 2019 at Camp Kappe.
- ❖ 2 Confirmation interviews one with Tina Hollopeter and one with clergy-Spring 2018.

Catholic High School Students

We recognize you attend daily theology classes as part of you day school curriculum. Preparation for the sacrament of confirmation is distinct and takes place within the parish community. In an effort to build community you are invited to attend weekly FF classes with your peers. You are required to attend FF the first Wednesday night of the month with your parent or sponsor as well as the two Sacramental Sundays. It is necessary for you to complete all the other requirements listed above.

Absences for Confirmation II

Teens are expected to attend all FF classes each year and one retreat each year. Teens must attend both **Sacramental Sundays** (or the makeup sacrament preparation sessions during Spring Break). Teens are only **allowed one regular FFP class absence** per semester. If there is an absence, please send an email to thollopeter@hrccr.com so it can be put in the teen's file. The Confirmation Retreat can be made up by attending a Confirmation Retreat at another parish.
